

Don't Move Firewood


A <u>REGULATION</u> is in effect that prohibits the import of firewood into New York unless it has been heat treated to kill pests. The regulation also limits the transportation of untreated firewood to less than 50 miles from its source. Section 192.5 of the NYS Environmental Conservation Law requires firewood transporters to carry a "Self Certification" form when moving firewood. More info. visit www.dec.ny.gov/animals/28722.html.

New infestations of insects and diseases can start if you take firewood with you when you travel. Keep our trees safe by following these tips:

- Don't take firewood with you when you go camping or hiking.
- Buy locally harvested firewood.
- Tell your friends not to move Firewood more than 50 miles.
- Obtain and carry a

"self-certification" form whenever you move bulk firewood.
